
MOORING LOCATIONS


MOORING HOUSEBOATS

Houseboats can be moored for up to 48 hours at any of Council's designated mooring sites - allowing equality of access for all. People wishing to moor longer than 48 hours must obtain a Council permit to do so. Approved Council Houseboat Mooring sites are listed below.

People wishing to moor longer than 48 hours must obtain a Council permit to do so. Permits are available at a rate of \$64 per day and can be obtained by submitting a Houseboat Mooring Application at the Local Government Centre, mailing to PO Box 421 MURRAY BRIDGE SA 5253 or via email council@murraybridge.sa.gov.au

Failure to obtain a permit for those who moor longer than 48 hours will result in fines.


MOORING HOUSEBOATS

Houseboats can be temporarily moored on Crown land for up to 21 days, but permanent mooring is only permitted with authorisation or in designated marinas. Some parts of the river are under freehold title and require landowner permission for mooring. Local councils may close dedicated Crown land due to changing water levels.

It's essential to regularly check mooring ropes and avoid mooring to trees as they may collapse due to softened ground or erosion caused by floodwaters. Recovery and re-floating of stranded houseboats are the owner's responsibility, and permission is required for vessels stranded for more than 21 days.

Mooring to existing structures may result in damage for which the owner is liable. Private land may require permission to moor.


MOORING HOUSEBOATS

When parking next to another houseboat

- Allow 30 metres between each vessel; this assists with the houseboat safety for reversing from the river bank
 - Every houseboat requires distance next to another vessel in case the rear of the houseboat moves side wards when reversing front the river bank
 - Moving the boat sideways is sometimes required to reverse the boat front the river bank if the boat is beached
 - The wind or current may move the houseboat sideways so a distance between each boat is important
 - Human strength will not be able to fend off the houseboat from hitting each other
- All front hatches need to remain closed when not in operation



Front handrail damage after mooring against a jetty at Mannum































HOW TO IDENTIFY CROWN LANDS IN THE MURRAY RIVER

Avenza Maps is a mobile app that allows users to download, view, and interact with maps on their mobile devices, even when they are offline.

Users can browse a vast library of maps from around the world, including topographic maps, nautical charts, and road maps. You can download the maps you need for offline use and mark up the maps with your own notes, waypoints, and tracks.

The app also has a feature called "GeoPDF" which allows users to import and interact with geospatial PDF files, including maps with embedded data such as points of interest, trails, and contour lines.

Avenza Maps also includes a built-in location tracking feature that allows users to see their location on the map and record their tracks. This can be useful for outdoor activities such as hiking, biking, and skiing.

The app is available for both iOS and Android devices.



























Download the Avenza Maps on your smartphone or tablet/iPad from the App Store or Google Play Store.

Open the Avenza Maps app on your device and sign in or create an account if you haven't already. Enter the email address you wish to use for your Avenza Maps account and choose a password. You will receive an email with a link to activate your account. Click on the link within 7 days to activate your account.

Once your account is activated, you can start exploring and using Avenza Maps. Click the import icon.

Locate and click on the QR code icon on the right-hand side of your screen. This will activate the QR scanner on your mobile device's camera. Scan the provided QR code and you will be automatically directed to the download page for the map.














Once the map is downloaded, you can use it offline to explore crown lands in the Murray River. To view the map, tap the "Maps" tab at the bottom of the screen and select the Wow Factor Crown Land Map from the list.


THINGS TO DO

The playground features a "spider" climbing structure comprised of a rope pyramid with ladders and swings on a soft fall base.































TAILEM BEND


BAKER RESERVE (WELLINGTON)







WEATHER FORECAST

Once in the river, it is important to check weather forecasts and monitor regular weather reports. You must be very careful to moor the houseboat in a suitable mooring location and be aware of the changing tides during the day and night. Beaching the houseboat can cause significant damage and you are likely to lose your bond and the \$5000 insurance excess by doing so.


The vessel should not be operated by Hirers during periods of

- high wind (i.e. force 7, which is > 50 kph or 30 knots)
- poor visibility, whether due to darkness, dust, fog or heavy rain
- strong current (> 6 kph)

The vessel should be firmly roped (both sides and fore & aft) to the bank during such times. Wow Houseboats will not permit you to commence your cruise under these conditions.



In NatureMaps, most navigation can be done using the mouse, but at times you may also use a key press in combination with a mouse click and dragging across the map.


If you're using a touch screen, touch a spot on the map and move your finger to move the map around. Double tap or pinch outwards to zoom in. Pinch inwards to zoom out.
